WHAT'S HAPPENING IN U3A:

With technology here to stay our Technical Coordinator has prepared an article explaining important usage instructions for you, in his **Tech Talk:**

Now we have settled into our year of sessions this is a good time to look at how you can get the best use of our admin system MYU3A. You can access through our website, myallu3a.org.au and then going to the MYU3A tab and selecting View And Change My Details

One of the most common problems is not knowing or remembering your member number of password. To recover this information, there is a FORGOT PASSWORD/ID on the login page. Click this and it will ask you for your email address. Enter that and you should then get an email with your details.

What can I do once I am in there?

Your details – Here you can see your membership details. If there is any information you want to change just click on the UPDATE PROFILE button and make your changes and when finished click COMMIT.

Class Information – here you can make changes to your classes. If you originally enrolled in a class but can no longer attend it is polite to the Convener and possibly anyone on a waitlist for a class, for you to delete the class from your profile. Simply click on CLASSES 2024 and follow the instructions on the next page. You can also enrol in another class on the same page.

I can't make it to a session – If you are unable to attend a class session or away for a while you can let you convener know through your profile page by inserting the dates you will be absent between and clicking on APOLOGISE.

When are all my classes? – Once you have finished updating your details you can click on NEXT and you will get a summary page of your profile and classes. You can use the PRINT button if you have a printer attached or take a photo of the screen with you phone.

When you are finished just click on EXIT to go back to our website.

EMERGENCY APP

I am well aware that some of us absolutely do not want to engage more with our mobile phones than absolutely necessary and I fully understand the reluctance. Many of us simply wish to use it the way we did in 'the good old' days - make and receive phone calls.! Fair enough! However, when an app comes along that could save our life we should prick up our ears and at least find out what it's all about. In brief: The Emergency Plus app, developed by Australia **Emergency Services and** their Government and Industry partners, is free of charge. Apparently it can alert emergency services to your location much quicker than you and your loved one could and thus could make the difference between life and death.
